CALLED MEETING
February 7, 2008

1. CALL MEETING TO ORDER; MAYOR GROOMS

Members present, Russell Davis, Randy Newman, Sylvia Prosser, Annette Wilson and William Hendrix.

The purpose of the meeting is to review applications and interview applicants. There were three applicants chosen, only two showed. Mayor Grooms dismissed council into The Council meeting room to proceed with the interviews.

The first applicant to be interviewed was Mac Oliver from Collins, Georgia. Mr. Oliver has been in the construction field for 15 years and has decided to look for a career that utilizes the skills he has already obtained. Mr. Oliver has done everything from foundations, to roofing and several large jobs in and around the Statesboro area. The most recent being the \$13,000.00 drywall contract for the new Pizza Inn on Hwy 80 West in Statesboro. Mr. Oliver has been married for 14 years and has an 8 year old son.

Our second applicant is Louie Mullis who has served as Mayor of Chester, which gave him numerous skills as a planner, organizer and manager. He has worked with different state agencies to help with the growth and prosperity of Chester and wants to offer the skills he has learned and promise to learn other skills that might be needed for the Town of Brooklet.

Following the interviews, Mayor Grooms asked Ms. Belle to contact the chosen applicant Within a week and make him an offer of \$28,000.00 to \$30,000.00 for 40 hours a week.
